

TRAVELING TO THE CONFERENCE

Flying to Atlanta

For delegates flying to Atlanta, please note that you will be flying into Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. There, you can easily find Uber/Lyft to take roughly a 20min drive (depending on traffic) to Emory University (201 Dowman Dr., Atlanta, GA 30322). Please note that if you requested a host for the weekend, he/she is not obligated to provide you transportation throughout the conference, and that it will be your responsibility to arrive at the conference venue.

We would also like to recommend choosing public transport as an eco-friendly and cost-effective alternative, the MARTA rail system offers convenient connections from the Airport to Emory University. Take the RED line (northbound) to Lindbergh Rail Station. From Lindbergh Rail station, bus route #6 serves several stops along Clifton Road, all of which are within walking distance from Emory University. Please note that MARTA does not run 24/7 and may be delayed by weather. We recommend checking the schedule for real-time updates. Emory University Transportation and Parking Services has also compiled a helpful list of limo and taxi services in the Metro Atlanta Area.

For those staying at a hotel, the airport has Uber/Lyft that can easily take you to your hotel location prior to the start of the conference. Please check the schedule on the AMWHO 2019 website to ensure you arrive at Emory for check-in.

Driving to Atlanta

For delegates driving to Atlanta, the official address of Emory University is 201 Dowman Drive. There are three main parking decks that will be open after 5 pm on weekdays and throughout the weekend. The four main decks are: Peavine, Fisburne, Oxford Road/Administration and the 1462 Clifton Rd./Rollins School of Public Health Parking Deck.

If you will be arriving before 5 pm and need parking validation, please email internal@amwho.org at least one week prior to the conference in order to ensure validation is available. We will provide your parking pass during check-in.
